
NOW BRINGING EMERGENCY ENERGY + WATER TO MEDICAL UNITS IN NEPAL

On April 25, Nepal was struck by a 7.8 magnitude earthquake.

THE CURRENT SITUATION: Thousands in Kathmandu are still sleeping on sidewalks, in parks, and in cars for fear of further aftershocks. Outside the city, entire villages were flattened, including rural health clinics and hospitals. Very little aid has made its way to the more remote areas, and the extent of the damage is still unknown. With over 7,500 reported earthquake injuries and the high likelihood of a health crisis, SunFarmer's current priority is in restoring power to the remaining health facilities, and equipping rural medical tents with mobile sources of power and water purification.



The electricity situation was dire even before the earthquake. Medical teams urgently need electricity and clean water to treat the injured and prevent disease outbreak.

HOW YOU CAN HELP: SunFarmer is coordinating delivery of mobile power generation and solar water purification equipment into Nepal. Our local Nepali team will focus on relief efforts for the foreseeable future. WHO WE ARE: SunFarmer is a social enterprise delivering affordable solar electricity for health, education, and agriculture in developing countries. The organization has deep roots in Nepal, with a local team and an engineering office in Kathmandu. They were focused on energy access before the earthquake, and will be there for the long road ahead, leveraging engineering expertise to help the country rebuild. SunFarmer's solar business offers rent-to-own financing for community solar projects, and they have completed installations for 7 health clinics and 3 schools to date.
